Subject: Frank Scott Parkway Water Main Bid

List of committees that have reviewed: Public Works Committee

Background: The City of O'Fallon has a policy of looping its water mains to provide better service to its customers and allow for continued service despite the need to shut down a portion of a main for repair. A 12" water main along Frank Scott Parkway from Hartman Lane to Green Mount Road is a part of that program. The portion from Green Mount Road to the Green Mount Lakes development area on Frank Scott Parkway has already been completed. The bid recently taken is to complete the needed work from Green Mount Lakes to Hartman. A low bid was received from M & I Construction of \$66,688.80 for the placing of the 12" water main along the northern edge of Frank Scott Parkway. Four of the six bidders were very competitive in the bid process, indicating that the bid overall was a good one. Our staff designed this project.

Legal Considerations, if any: None beyond those normally associated with construction contract award.

Budget Impact: Water line construction funds were budgeted for this work in CY 2004.

Staff recommendation: Recommend approval of work by Christ Brothers in the amount of \$66,688.80.
