Subject: Vine Street Repair Bid

List of committees that have reviewed: Public Works Committee

Background: Vine Street from 5th Street south to Parkview is in poor condition. The existing road is a thin oil and chip surface over a thin base. Traffic and especially the large trash service trucks are reducing it to a dirt road. Reconstruction will remove the existing paving materials and excessive crown. The new pavement will be constructed from the millings off our pavement overlay project and topped with an asphalt layer. Existing curbs will be used for the paving edge. Six bids were obtained for the work, with the low bid from Christ Brothers at \$91,287.25. Three of the six bidders were very competitive in the bid process, indicating that the bid overall was a good one. Rhutasel Engineering provided an analysis of the bidding with a recommendation to accept the low bid.

Legal Considerations, if any: None beyond those normally associated with construction contract award.

Budget Impact: Proposition S funding is available for the work.

Staff recommendation: Recommend approval of work by Christ Brothers in the amount of \$91,287.25.
