**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH
THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW HEIGHTS TO ALLOW THE FAIRVIEW HEIGHTS POLICE DEPARTMENT
TO PROVIDE POLICE SERVICES FOR A PORTION OF OLD COLLINSVILLE RD SOUTH OF
HIGHWAY 50 THAT IS WITH THE CITY LIMIT OF O'FALLON**

WHEREAS, the City of O'Fallon and the City of Fairview Heights are authorized and empowered by Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and 5 ILCS 220/1 et seq., to enter into intergovernmental agreements, for any purpose, not prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, a portion of Old Collinsville Road, south of the intersection of U S Highway 50 and Old Collinsville Road, lies within the Municipal boundaries of the City of O'Fallon and adjoins the City of Fairview Heights; and

WHEREAS, Section 5/7-4-7 and Section 5/7-4-8 of the Municipal Code allows the police force of one municipality to be used in an adjoining municipality; and

WHEREAS, the City of O'Fallon desires to have the City of Fairview Heights, through its Police Department, patrol the Designated Area for the purpose of enforcing traffic and criminal ordinances and laws; and

WHEREAS, Fairview Heights police force is an able and functioning department capable of patrolling the Designated Area for the purposes of enforcing traffic and criminal ordinances and laws; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairview Heights is willing through its police department to patrol the Designated Area for the purposes of enforcing traffic and criminal ordinances and laws.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:**

That the City of O'Fallon authorizes the Mayor to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Fairview Heights for the purpose of authorizing the Fairview Heights police to provide police services on the stretch of Old Collinsville Rd. described.
