

ORDINANCE NO.

**AMENDING CHAPTER 52,
OF THE CITY CODE OF
ORDINANCES WITH
REGARD TO A WATER
RATE INCREASE**

WHEREAS, Section 52.022 (D) calls for a hotel/motel tap applied to each dwelling unit; and

WHEREAS, after careful review and consideration, the City Council finds this to no longer be of economic advantage to the city; and

WHEREAS, the 40 year agreement with Illinois American Water Company calls for an annual rate increase base on the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Data, Consumer Price Index, U.S. City Average, Water and Sewerage Maintenance, May index; and

WHEREAS, the index grew by 6.85% in the reporter period;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of O’Fallon, Illinois, assembled that Chapter 52, Sections 52.022, 52.080, 52.081 and 52.083 be amended as follows:

Sec. 52.022 Taps and water service cost and installation, Paragraph (D)

“With regards to hotel and motel tap fee shall be 50% of tap applies to each dwelling unit” be deleted.

Sec. 52.080 Water inside city.

The established rates for the sale of water within the corporate limits of the ~~city~~ City of O’Fallon are as follows:

First 9,000 gallons per quarter or less: ~~\$2.82~~ \$3.02 per 1,000 gallons.

Next 15,000 gallons per quarter or less: ~~\$3.14~~ \$3.36 per 1,000 gallons.

Next 720,000 gallons per quarter or less: ~~\$2.90~~ \$3.10 per 1,000 gallons.

Next 1,245,000 gallons per quarter or less: ~~\$2.28~~ \$2.44 per 1,000 gallons.

All over 2,010,000 gallons per quarter: ~~\$2.03~~ \$2.17 per 1,000 gallons.

The minimum charge to all customers supplied through five-eighths (5/8) inch meter shall be ~~eight dollars and forty six cents (\$8.46)~~ nine dollars and six cents (\$9.06) per month or ~~twenty five dollars and thirty eight cents (\$25.38)~~ twenty-seven dollars and eighteen cents (\$27.18) per quarter, with a proportionate charge for meters of larger size, based upon the area of the outlet opening of the meter and shall apply as a service charge whether water is used during the period or not.

Sec. 52.081. Rates for Fairview Heights.

The established rates for the sale of water within the corporate limits of the City of Fairview Heights are as follows:

First 9,000 gallons per quarter or less: ~~\$3.78~~ \$4.04 per 1,000 gallons.

Next 15,000 gallons per quarter or less: ~~\$3.82~~ \$4.09 per 1,000 gallons.

Next 720,000 gallons per quarter or less ~~\$3.54~~ \$3.79 per 1,000 gallons.

Next 1,245,000 gallons per quarter or less ~~\$2.78~~ \$2.97 per 1,000 gallons.

All over 2,010,000 gallons per quarter ~~\$2.50~~ \$2.68 per 1,000 gallons.

The minimum charge to all customers supplied through a five-eighths (5/8) inch meter shall be ~~eleven dollars and thirty four cents (\$11.34)~~ twelve dollars and thirteen cents (\$12.13) or ~~thirty four dollars and two cents (\$34.02)~~ thirty-six dollars and thirty nine cents (\$36.39) per quarter, with a proportionate charge for meters of larger size based upon the area of the outlet opening of the meter and shall apply as a service charge whether water is used during the period or not.

Sec. 52.082 Outside corporate limits.

Rates for the sale of water from the water system of the city outside the corporate limits of the city and the corporate limits of the City of Fairview Heights shall be the same as in section 52.080, with a surcharge of thirty-five percent (35%) as follows:

First 9,000 gallons per quarter or less: ~~\$3.81~~ \$4.08 per 1,000 gallons.

Next 15,000 gallons per quarter or less: ~~\$4.24~~ \$4.54 per 1,000 gallons.

Next 720,000 gallons per quarter or less: ~~\$3.92~~ \$4.19 per 1,000 gallons.

Next 1,245,000 gallons per quarter or less: ~~\$3.08~~ \$3.30 per 1,000 gallons.

All over 2,010,000 gallons per quarter ~~\$2.74~~ \$2.93 per 1,000 gallons.

The minimum charge to all customers supplied through a five-eighths (5/8) inch meter shall be twelve dollars and twenty four cents (\$12.24) or thirty-six dollars and seventy two cents (\$36.72) per quarter, with a proportionate charge for meters of larger size based upon the area of the outlet opening of the meter and shall apply as a service charge whether water is used during the period or not.

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The usage rate shall be subject to increase effective on each annual anniversary, beginning October, 2004, based upon the annual increase in the Bureau of Labor Statistics, Consumer Price Index, All Urban Consumers, US City Average, Water and

Sewer Maintenance, or comparable index if the same is no longer published, for the month of May.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
