**Subject:** AMENDMENTS TO PARKING ORDINANCES

**List of committees that have reviewed:** Public Safety (unanimous approval)

**Background:** As a result of reviewing the variety of ordinances that address parking, both on and off-street, the Public Safety Committee has recommended the following changes to two current ordinances to keep pace with some emerging situations:

1. Change ordinance 72.10(A)(2)(d) to prohibit parking within 30 feet of any intersection, unless otherwise approved by the City Engineer. The current ordinance prohibits parking within 30 feet of intersections that have traffic control signs or signals. This language allows parking in encroach on intersections along streets that do not have traffic control signs. This creates a sight limitation.
2. Change ordinance 72.21(B) to prohibit the on-street parking of recreational vehicles and allow class "C" vehicles.
