**Subject:** Special Event Permit – “Cinco de Mayo” Sponsored by Chevy’s Mexican Grill

### **Background:**

- Applicant: Chevy’s Mexican Restaurant
- Special Events Permit for Cinco de Mayo Event from May 5<sup>th</sup> through May 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Event will occur from 11 AM to 1AM each day.
- Alcohol and food sales will happen within a tent on premise.
- Additional parking will be provided at Garden Ridge, with GR consent.
- Will be providing security guards and additional restroom facilities.
- No special requests from the city.
- A live band will perform on Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 7PM to 12PM.

**Legal Considerations, if any:** None

**Budget Impact:** None.

**Staff recommendation:** The Fire Department commented that parking lot activities shall be monitored so that the tent and restroom facilities do not impede access to emergency equipment. Recommendation: Approval.
