Subject: 4-Way Stop, Thornbury Place and Victoria

List of committees that have reviewed: Public Works and Public Safety

Background: The Public Works Committee received a staff report approximately a year ago stating that the intersection met warrant for a 4-way stop due to sight restrictions along Thornbury Place. Residents had asked for the stop sign there as many young children use the intersection's sidewalks to get to Moyer Elementary. The committee at that time approved the 4-way stop contingent upon submission to the committee a petition signed by the neighborhood residents. As the petition was not produced, the issue died. The issue was re-introduced to the Public Safety Committee and the area residents have now provided the signed petition.

Legal Considerations, if any: None.

Budget Impact: An allowance for miscellaneous signage is included in the yearly Public Works budget.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends passage of the ordinance amending the schedule for three and four way stop intersections to include Victoria and Thornbury Place.
