**Subject:** Resolution No. \_\_\_\_\_: A Resolution Approving a Certificate of Merit (Heritage Award) for the United Church of Christ, church building at 206 W. Adams Street.

**List of committees that have reviewed:** The Community Development Committee reviewed the request and recommends approval. The committee had no concerns with the award.

**Background:**

- Heritage Award for the United Church of Christ, church building located at 206 W. Adams Street.
- The Heritage Award is a Certificate of Merit for certain properties which may not qualify for landmark designation or their owners do not wish to shoulder the legal responsibilities of designation status. The award is a non-binding public recognition of the structures and the property owner's efforts in maintaining and improving them.
- The property meets the following designation criteria: 1. Significance or value as part of the historical, cultural, artistic, social, ethnic, political, or other heritage of the community, state or nation; and, 8. Representation of a sense of time and place unique to the City.
- The Historic Preservation Commission reviewed the application request and recommends approval of the Heritage Award.
