**Subject:** Azteca Systems Cityworks Concurrent Use Software Purchase  
Authorization

**List of committees that have reviewed:** This item has not been reviewed by Committee.

**Background:** The Cityworks software allows the Engineering and Public Works Department to manage maintenance of infrastructure assets, to document service requests and to more easily interact with GIS map data for such things as valve isolation traces for water main breaks, documentation and prioritization of deficiencies revealed by smoke testing of sanitary sewers and other important management and emergency response tasks. The City currently has 3 single use licenses of the Cityworks EX ArcGIS Extension software. The single use software allows "power users" of the Cityworks software to have unlimited access to the software for a cost effective price. However, we are ready to expand access to the software to users who only need access for a portion of the day or on an intermittent basis. This purchase authorization seeks permission to purchase 1 concurrent use license of Cityworks. This license can be installed on any number of computers throughout the organization; however, it allows only one user at a time.

**Budget Impact:** Money has been allocated for this purchase in the FY2006 Budget.

**Staff recommendation:** Staff recommends authorizing this purchase from Azteca Systems in the amount of \$14,995.
