Subject: ORDINANCE – Temporary Hydrant Meter Charge

Background: Despite rate adjustments for water service to residential and commercial customers, the rates for temporary hydrant meters used by construction contractors have not been adjusted since 1999. Staff has proposed an amended set of rates that establishes administrative fees and deposit requirements in addition to water sales at the out of corporate rate for water usage. The changes are shown on the attached page.
