**Subject:** RESOLUTION - Betty Lane Sewer Extension Construction

**Background:** One septic system on Betty Lane has failed, and the County has issued a citation to the landowner to connect to the O'Fallon sanitary sewer system. Due to all the utilities and roadway that would be affected by an extension to serve this single residence, Engineering had HMG Engineers design an extension that would serve as many parcels of land along the lane as possible to allow amortization of the effort at some future date. With engineering documents completed, bids were requested. There were five bidders with Rite-Way Excavating submitting the low bid of \$60,924.77 for the 750-foot sewer extension. The final engineer's estimate was \$64,022.00

**Legal Considerations, if any:** Normal execution of contract concerns.

**Budget Impact:** There were no extensions allowed for in the FY06 budget. Funding from other line items would be required to pay for this extension.

**Staff Recommendation:** Staff recommends that the Betty Lane Sewer Extension Project be awarded to Rite-Way Excavating for \$60,924.77 to provide the area with sanitary service. O'Fallon as a sanitary sewer provider needs to ensure that such service is available where reasonable to further protect the environment. The bid tab is attached.
