Subject: MOTION – Large Street Signage Procurement and Installation

List of committees that have reviewed: Public Works

Background: The City of O'Fallon has received two grants from the Area Agency on Aging for procurement of the signs. Total amount is \$8,375. After lengthy coordination with IDOT over the type of font to be used and the permissible size of the signs, a contractor has been located that can provide the approved IDOT font. The installation will be by an IDOT qualified contractor with the local area contract for that work at the IDOT contracted rate. The large signs are to make it easier for drivers to read the cross street name from a distance.

Legal Considerations, if any: Normal concerns when contracting for work and materials.

Budget Impact: The \$7,401.77 needed for the signs is covered by the grants. The installation of the signs on traffic signal masts is \$9,800, and will be covered by funds allocated for sign installation and replacement in the Streets Division Budget.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends approving the purchase and installation of the signs for a grand total of \$17,201.22. United Rentals is the sign provider. Erection of the signage will be by Electrico.
