Subject: RESOLUTION – Gonzalez Companies Construction Inspection, Elm &
Orchard Area Mine Subsidence Repair

Background: The Elm & Orchard Mine Subsidence Project has been bid and construction will begin as soon as materials for the work can be delivered. As the project will take place in the front yards of many residents and their sewer laterals will be replaced as the project progresses, construction inspection and coordination of the project will be critical. Contract services for the bulk of the construction inspection is needed to allow in-house assets to pursue other assignments. As Pat Judge of Gonzalez Companies is the supervising engineer over the project, use of a Gonzalez employee to do the construction inspection will facilitate coordination between project engineer and inspector.

Legal Considerations, if any: Normal contractual legal obligations.

Budget Impact: The scope of this proposal is for \$27,695 worth of support is included in professional services within the budgets for water, wastewater, and streets.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends acceptance of the proposal from Gonzalez Companies.
