**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING
AS A LOCAL HISTORIC
LANDMARK 505 SOUTH CHERRY
STREET IN O'FALLON, ILLINOIS,
PURSUANT TO THE
REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER
151 OF THE O'FALLON CODE OF
ORDINANCES
(Parcel number 04-30.0-424-003, also
known as the Amelia Carriel
Fountain)**

WHEREAS, Chapter 151 of the City of O'Fallon Code of Ordinances provides rules and parameters for designating historic structures and districts; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 151 gives the commission responsibility for recommending to the City Council those structures or districts that have significant local, state or national historical or architectural importance; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has received and accepted an application from O'Fallon Community Consolidated School District #90, owner of the structure located at 505 S Cherry Street, commonly known as the Amelia Carriel Fountain, for designation as a local historic landmark; and

WHEREAS, the Commission held a public hearing pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 151 on March 7, 2006 to consider the designation of the structure located at 505 S Cherry Street as a local historic landmark; and

WHEREAS, the Commission unanimously recommends to the City Council that the structure located at 505 S Cherry Street in the City of O'Fallon represents a structure that a) has significant value as part of the historical, cultural, artistic, social, ethnic, political, or other heritage of the community, state, or nation; b) has significance or value for identification with a person who significantly contributed to the development of the community, county, state or nation; and c) represents a sense of time and place unique to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings. Based upon the City Council's review of the application and the testimony giving at the public hearing, and having made itself familiar with the project, the council makes the following affirmative determinations: the structure located at 505 S Cherry Street a) has significant value as part of the historical, cultural, artistic, social, ethnic, political, or other heritage of the community, state,
