Subject: ORDINANCE – No Parking Vine Street Parking Lot

List of committees that have reviewed: Public Safety Committee and Public Works Committee

Background: Heavy commercial vehicles are increasingly using the lot which cannot support the weight of these vehicles as the lot was designed as a commuter and downtown customer parking. Additionally, commercial vehicles use the lot overnight and for long-term parking. Their activity is an annoyance to nearby residents.

Legal Considerations, if any: None, traffic control per accepted standards.

Budget Impact: An allowance for miscellaneous signage is included in the yearly Public Works budget.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends passage of the ordinance amending the schedule for no parking of commercial vehicles in this area except when such vehicle parking is in the best interest of the City, such as vehicles in the City for Mayfest or Homecoming, and then only by permit issued by the Department of Engineering and Public Works.
