**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI,
CHAPTER 110, SECTION 110.04,
REGARDING BUSINESS
REGISTRATION DURATION**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2031 was passed regarding the duration of the initial business registration and renewals and;

WHEREAS, it has become cumbersome to renew all businesses during the month of April and;

WHEREAS, there shall be a pro-ration period to initiate the change in renewal cycle which will stagger the renewal cycle for all standing businesses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O’FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 110.04 is amended as:

- (A) Business must be registered before operating within the City limits.
- (B) Registrations are effective from one year of the anniversary date of approval.
- (C) The City Clerk shall notify the registered business of the impending expiration date within thirty (30) days of expiration. However, it is the obligation of each business to renew its registration and failure to receive an expiration notification is not a defense for operating without a registration.

Upon its passage and approval, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
