Subject: RESOLUTION - Agreement with Hoelscher Engineering for
605 Madison (Referred to as "Hesse Lake and Drainage Study by
Hoelscher)

Background: Hoelscher Engineering was asked to submit a proposal for topographic surveying, hydrologic and hydraulic analysis, a schematic improvement design, and preliminary cost estimates of a remediation of the problem associated with erosion caused at the rear of 605 Madison along a reach of Engle Creek at the southwest corner of Hesse Park from a city culvert pipe there. The area under consideration is more than the complaint at the rear of 605 Madison. As Hesse Park is just north of this location, more than just a remediation of the erosion at 605 may be possible if some of the land of the park may be altered to better receive the flow from upstream. So, future planning data will be collected under this effort.

Legal Considerations, if any: None beyond that for obtaining consulting services.

Budget Impact: Funding for this analysis and support work will come from Proposition S funds set aside for stormwater engineering.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends execution of the RESOLUTION agreement with Hoelscher not to exceed the amount of \$18,600 for the subject services needed to assess the problem and determine a future course of action.
