Subject: RESOLUTION – Parcs at Arbor Green Water Main Proposal

List of committees that have reviewed: Public Works Committee.

Background: LW Contractors has proposed to construct a 16” waterline, 3,320 lineal feet, to service the Parcs at Arbor Green and other future development along Simmons Road for \$144,488 which includes a credit to the City for the water line that they would need to provide along the frontage of the Parcs. Staff has reviewed the proposal and finds all values contained within to correlate with current prices that the City is paying for similar work elsewhere in our system without exception. The 16” line is needed to meet the improvements to the water distribution in this area that will extend further south to Venita Drive and Highway 50 as well as Hinchcliffe Elementary next year as part of our ongoing distribution improvement program.

Legal Considerations, if any: Normal concerns when engaging construction services.

Budget Impact: Funding for this project is contained in the FY07 budget.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends execution of the agreement with passage of the resolution for a cost of construction not to exceed \$144,488 based on the unit prices quoted.
