

A RESOLUTION CREATING A POLICY STATEMENT REGARDING A JOINT LAND USE STUDY

WHEREAS, the Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) program is a U.S. Defense Department initiative and has two major objectives: “(1) to encourage cooperative land use planning between military installations, the surrounding communities and St. Clair County so that future growth and development are compatible with the training or operational missions of the installation and (2) to seek ways to reduce the operational impacts on adjacent land” (Joint Land Use Study, Program Guidance Manual, August 2002, P.2.); and

WHEREAS, Scott Air Force Base and its operations represent a significant contribution to the local and regional economy and its continuing safe and effective operations require special land use considerations; and

WHEREAS, the City of O’Fallon recognizes the overriding importance of protecting the health, safety and welfare of City residents as well as the future of Scott Air Force Base; and,

WHEREAS, the City of O’Fallon recognizes the importance of implementing appropriate measures for compatible land use development in and around Scott Air Force Base.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O’FALLON AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) Approval. The City of O’Fallon will engage in the JLUS as an active participant on the JLUS Policy Committee. The City of O’Fallon will provide in-kind support for the JLUS. The City of O’Fallon will provide a good faith commitment to implement appropriate recommendations to ensure only compatible development within Accident Potential Zones and areas impacted by high noise in the JLUS study area; and
- 2) Resolution Recorded with Clerk. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file and maintain a copy of this resolution in the Office of the City Clerk; and

3) Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption
by the City Council.
