Subject: RESOLUTION – Traffic Counts

List of committees that have reviewed: None.

Background: Traffic counts are used as a means of determining the need for transportation projects and spot trends in traffic growth to allow proactive traffic management. With the growth in the City, certain road segments and intersections may be reaching capacity. Counting existing traffic is the way that is determined. The last traffic counts conducted for the City were in 2000. This effort will perform manual, turning movement counts for 12 hours at 8 locations. The locations are S. Lincoln at Dartmouth Drive, Milburn School Road at Old Collinsville Road, I-64 Frontage Road at Old Collinsville Road, Fairwood Hills Road at Simmons Road, State Street at Oberneufemann Road, Lincoln Avenue at Deer Creek Road, Porter Road at Simmons Road, and Old Vincennes Road at Seven Hills Drive.

Legal Considerations, if any: None.

Budget Impact: The scope of this proposal is for \$7,630 to be funded from the Streets budget.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends acceptance of the proposal from Crawford, Bunte, Brammeier for \$7,630.
