**Subject:** RESOLUTION – Adams & Penn Street Storm Sewer Surveying & Engineering Support by Rhutasel and Associates

**List of Committees that have reviewed:** None.

**Background:** Stormwater from the 400 & 500 blocks of E. Adams and Washington Streets has no organized way of getting to a reach of Engle Creek. As such, it meanders through a number of backyard alley and roadside ditches as well as side yard ditches and culvert pipes. The drainage at time stalls and leaves yards and roadways a mess. After analyzing the requirement for drainage of this area, staff has determined that a trunk storm sewer main east down Adams from the 400 block to Penn is needed (see attached map), and an additional main north down Penn may be required as well dependent upon drainage calculations. The proposal by Rhutasel is to provide the necessary topographic surveying of the area down Adams and from Adams down Penn to Madison where an existing storm sewer down Penn from State discharges into a reach of Engle Creek. Additionally, Rhutasel will be used to provide engineering support as the design of the piping progresses. Once the proposed trunk main is in place, additional connector mains to drain the problem areas can be designed. The design of those mains will be under separate proposals.

**Legal Considerations, if any:** None beyond normal consultant contract concerns.

**Budget Impact:** Funding for this project will be from FY08 Proposition S funds.

**Staff Recommendation:** Accept proposal by Rhutasel in an amount not to exceed \$81,000, see attached proposal.
