Subject: MOTION – 3” Hydrant Meters

List of Committees that have reviewed: Public Works Committee

Background: The City of O'Fallon Public Works Operations Group requested a quote for 6 each, 3-inch hydrant meters with integrated backflow device from Midwest Municipal Supply of Collinsville, IL. The price quoted was \$6,600 each for a total of \$39,600. The meters are to be used at the Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) for washdown purposes, by the Streets Division for sweeper operations and vehicle cleaning, by the Sewer Lines Division for Vactor truck sewer line cleaning and line dying operations, and Water Division for boring machine filling. Two meters will be used for rental to contractors and developers for construction operations. The Group needs to account for the water they use in their operation. The meters requested match the ones already in possession by the Water Division for rental to contractors.

Legal Considerations, if any: None.

Budget Impact: This is will be paid out of maintenance funds allocated in the varying divisions' budgets.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends procurement of the hydrant meters with backflow devices \$39,600.
