**Subject:** RESOLUTION – North Lincoln (O'Fallon-Troy Road) Roundabout Study Proposal

**List of committees that have reviewed:** Public Works

**Background:** St. Clair County has not provided for any intersection improvements at the intersections of Bowler, O'Fallon-Troy and Bethel School Roads with their current design of the reconstruction of O'Fallon-Troy Road. Staff asked for a proposal from Oates Associates for the collection of data, preparation of a traffic study, roundabout intersection layout and construction cost estimates in August of 2006. Oates was chosen as they are the designers of the County's planned improvements to O'Fallon-Troy Road, and as a result have a large amount of the surveying needed to be done to design a roundabout already in their possession. A roundabout at the location of Bowler and O'Fallon-Troy Roads would provide for improved traffic patterns at a location that some day could be the center of the City. Please see attached.

**Legal Considerations, if any:** None beyond that for obtaining consulting services.

**Budget Impact:** Funding for this effort will come from the FY08 Streets Fund.

**Staff recommendation:** Staff recommends execution of the RESOLUTION agreement with Oates in an amount not to exceed \$17,500.
