RESOLUTION 2007 -

**AUTHORIZING A REFERENDUM VOTE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE
FEBRUARY 2008 PRIMARY BALLOT ON THE QUESTION AS TO THE CITY OF
O'FALLON CREATING SEWER LATERAL REPAIR PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of O'Fallon, a municipal corporation, needs to determine whether a sewer lateral repair program should be created to service property owners in the City, and

WHEREAS, St. Clair County will be holding Primary elections in February 2008 which will provide the City the opportunity to hold a vote on a referendum to support a sewer lateral repair program,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:**

The City of O'Fallon authorizes its appropriate representatives to place on the primary ballot a referendum question on a sewer lateral repair program consisting of language as follows:

“Should the City of O'Fallon collect a Sewer Lateral Repair Fee of \$2.40 per month from the owner of any residential property (single family home or condominium) served by the O'Fallon Sanitary Sewer District within the City of O'Fallon for replacement of a defective sewer lateral (from main to building)?”
