RESOLUTION 2007 -

**AUTHORIZING A REFERENDUM VOTE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE  
FEBRUARY 2008 PRIMARY BALLOT ON THE QUESTION AS TO THE CITY OF  
O'FALLON CREATING A STORMWATER UTILITY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of O'Fallon, a municipal corporation, needs to determine whether a stormwater utility should be formed to service property owners in the City, and

**WHEREAS**, St. Clair County will be holding Primary elections in February 2008 which will provide the City the opportunity to hold a vote on a referendum to support a stormwater utility,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:**

The City of O'Fallon authorizes its appropriate representatives to place on the primary ballot a referendum question as follows:

*“Should the City of O'Fallon collect a Stormwater Utility Fee of \$3.45 per month from the owner(s) of single family residential property and a fee from owner(s) of other property based on a property's impervious surface to fund needed stormwater infrastructure and remediation as well as regulatory compliance?”*
