RESOLUTION 2007 -

**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT WITH THE SOUTHWESTERN ILLINOIS LAW
ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING A
PRISim TRAINING SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/5) provides that any one or more public agencies may contract with any one or more other public agencies to perform any government service, activity or undertaking which any of the public agencies entering into the agreement is authorized by law to perform, provided that such agreement shall be authorized by the governing body of each party to the agreement; and

WHEREAS, The Southwestern Illinois Law Enforcement Commission Assist 14 MTU has entered into an agreement with Advanced Interactive Systems for the purchase of a PRISim use of force training system for a total cost of \$83,120; and

WHEREAS, As a non-taxing government body, the Southwestern Illinois Law Enforcement Commission Assist 14 MTU does not qualify for discounted interest rates offered to other government bodies resulting in additional cost to participating agencies, including the O'Fallon Police Department; and

WHEREAS, The City of O'Fallon is willing to use its role as a taxing government body to finance the PRISim system through the Bank of Edwardsville for a total of five (5) years with all cost associated with the purchase and finance of the equipment to be reimbursed to the City by the Southwestern Illinois Law Enforcement Commission Assist 14 MTU; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS
FOLLOWS:**

That the City of O'Fallon authorizes the Mayor to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Southwestern Illinois Law Enforcement Commission Assist 14 MTU for the purpose of providing financing for a PRISim training system for five (5) years through the Bank of Edwardsville.
