**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
CHAPTER 94 OF THE O’FALLON,  
ILLINOIS CODE OF ORDINANCES  
PROVIDING FOR THE  
REGULATION OF NUISANCES  
WITHIN THE CITY**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of O’Fallon is authorized to enact any ordinance that it deems necessary for the promotion of health or the suppression of diseases, pass and enforce all necessary police ordinances, and define, prevent, and abate nuisances; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the keeping or harboring of an excessive number of animals within the City constitutes a nuisance that is injurious to the public health, safety, morals, general welfare and convenience; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O’FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** Section 94.01, Nuisances Enumerated, of the O’Fallon, Illinois Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding the following subsection (AD):

(AD) To keep or harbor more than a total of three (3) dogs and/or cats over the age of (4) four months on any premises that is not a lawfully operated kennel or veterinary clinic.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
