

## **Carson and Behrens Streets Sewer Project, Phase 1**

### **Narrative:**

This is a three phase project consisting of the removal and replacement of an abandoned sewer line and the installation of new lines to allow a Low/Mod community in O'Fallon Township, currently using deteriorating septic tanks, to connect to the City of O'Fallon sanitary sewer system. Phase 1 consists of installation of one 330 lineal foot run of 8-inch diameter sanitary sewer pipe south of Maple Street between Behrens Street and Carson Drive. Phase 1 also includes removal and replacement of 550 lineal feet of abandoned sanitary sewer line along Pine Street between Behrens Street and Estate Drive. (See attached)
