### **Background:**

- Applicant: James Otto for Chevy's Fresh Mex Restaurant
- Special Event Permit for annual Cinco de Mayo Celebration
- Event will be held on May 3 & 5, 2008
- Location: Chevy's Fresh Mex Restaurant at 1305 Central Park Drive
- Hours of Operation:
  - Saturday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> – DJ 1pm to 5pm; Smash Band from 6:30pm to 11:30pm
  - Monday, May 5<sup>th</sup> – DJ from 1 to 5pm; Johnny Rock-Itt Band from 6 to 11pm
- There will be singing, dancing, food and drinks.
- As with previous years, a tent will be placed outside and removed on Tuesday morning, May 6<sup>th</sup>.
- Security will be provided by 5 security personnel.
- Six portable toilets will be provided on site.
- Signage includes banners, pennants, streamers and a Miller blow-up feature. Staff has requested more information about the Miller blow-up feature, including dimensions and a photo. We expect to have that information available for the committee on Monday night.
- Additional parking will be provided at Garden Ridge.
- The Fire Department approved the event with no exceptions.
- Event is consistent with previous years' requests.
