Subject: RESOLUTION – St. Clair Water Tank, Exterior Painting Proposal

List of committees that have reviewed: Public Works

Background: The City of O'Fallon requested that Rhutasel and Associates carry out a follow up inspection of the water tank to address recommendations by our corrosion control contractor after maintenance of our cathodic protection at the tank. Rhutasel contacted Diversified Coatings of O'Fallon to provide a proposal for the work on the interior and base of tower. With that proposal, Diversified gave the City a quote for painting the entire exterior of the tank. Recently, we bid the exterior and interior painting of a ground storage tank and the low bid was \$112,500. Therefore, the proposal to paint the exterior of the St. Clair Tank for \$25,500 which due to its height is more difficult to paint is a very attractive price.

Legal Considerations, if any: Normal concerns when entering into an agreement with a contractor.

Budget Impact: The cost of this project is \$25,500.00 and will be covered by Water Operations Budget.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends the City accept the proposal from Diversified Coatings in the amount of \$25,500.
