RESOLUTION 2008 -

**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT WITH ST. CLAIR COUNTY TO ALLOW THE CITY TO
ACCESS THE 800 MHz TRUNKED RADIO SYSTEM FOR RADIO
COMMUNICATIONS FOR POLICE, FIRE, EMS AND PUBLIC WORKS**

WHEREAS, The City of O'Fallon has been recognized as a "sub-grantee" as a part of a Countywide Public Safety Interoperable Communications Grant (PSIG) allowing for the conversion of the remaining fixed and mobile radio equipment to the 800 MHz spectrum; and

WHEREAS, St. Clair County operates and maintains the radio system and has certain requirements regarding subscriber access and use; and

WHEREAS, A previous Memorandum of Understanding between the two parties allows for the City of O'Fallon to access the system at no charge in exchange for allowing certain parts of the radio system infrastructure to be erected on City property; and

WHEREAS, The requirements outlined in the Memorandum of Understanding are reasonably necessary for the efficient and legal operation of the Countywide system; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS
FOLLOWS:**

That the City of O'Fallon authorizes the Mayor to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with St. Clair County that allows the City access to the Countywide 800 MHz interoperable radio system for official Government business.
