Subject: ORDINANCE – No Parking, East Side of Oak Street,
Between 2nd Street and 3rd Street

List of committees that have reviewed: Public Safety.

Background: – A section of this area is currently “No Parking” in the City ordinances. It is from the northeast corner of the intersection of 3rd and Oak Street to just north of the vehicle access gate to St Clare School off Oak. That is only a length of about 50-feet. The school, however, requested of the Public Works Operations Group to make the whole length of the east side of Oak Street between 2nd and 3rd no parking and they have signed and painted the curb as such.

Legal Considerations, if any: None.

Budget Impact: Public Works has funds in its current operating budget for the signage and painting.

Staff recommendation: Authorize the change to the City’s “No Parking Zones” ordinance to match the signage and curb painting that is now in existence on the east side of Oak Street between 2nd and 3rd.
