**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE CITY CODE, CHAPTER 71
AND 77 RELATING TO TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, an unpaved emergency vehicle road crossing exists south of Famous Drive on property belonging to Central School, District #104 and accessing a closed stub-street extension to Long Drive and appears to be subject to use for non-emergency vehicle purposes thereby creating traffic and safety concerns, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to prohibit such unintended traffic other than emergency vehicles and to allow for penalties for such violation as provided by the traffic code;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Chapter 71 of the City Code of the City of O'Fallon is hereby amended by enacting a new Section 71.148 "Closed Streets" as follows

71.148. Closed Streets. No person shall drive any vehicle onto or across any road or intersection designated as a closed road on Schedule VIII, "Closed Roads" of Chapter 77, Traffic schedules, except for such exceptions as may be provided therein. The City Engineer shall be authorized to place signage, barricades, or other traffic control devices to effect this provision.

Section 2: Chapter 77, Traffic Schedules, Schedule VIII, "Closed Streets," of the City Code of Ordinances of the City of O'Fallon, is hereby amended by adding the following street regulation as follows:

SCHEDULE VIII. CLOSED STREETS.

The following streets are closed to traffic at the designated locations as follows:

<i>Closed Street</i>	Location	Ord. No.	Date Passed
Long Drive	The drive accessing Central School on the west side of Long Drive south of Famous Drive (except for emergency vehicles).		

Section 3: Whoever violates any provision of this ordinance for which another penalty is not already otherwise provided by the City Traffic Code or by appropriate statutory penalty as generally set forth in ILCS Ch. 625, Act 5, §§ 16-101 et seq. shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine as provided in § 10.99.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
