Subject: RESOLUTION – Phased Street and Stormwater Improvements
(Phases 1, 2, & 3) Design Proposal

List of committees that have reviewed: None

Background: Rhutasel and Associates have submitted a design proposal for the first 3 phases of the 10 phase project to rehabilitate E. Washington and E. Adams Streets from Vine to Smiley.

- Phase 1 is to construct a stormwater force main from the proposed detention pond at 410 E. Washington along the south side of the alley between that location and an existing stormwater main along Penn Street, construct a gravity storm sewer from the future detention area at 413 E. Adams down the alley between E. Washington and E. Adams to Orange Street, reconstruct the sanitary sewer from a point in the alley between E. Washington and E. Adams from 413 E. Adams to an existing manhole on Orange Street, and construct a “green alley” or thickened edge concrete alley from 413 E. Adams to Orange Street.
- Phase 2 is to construct a stormwater pumping station at 410 E. Washington Street connecting to the stormwater force main placed in Phase 1 and construct stormwater detention ponds at both 410 E. Washington and 413 E. Adams.
- Phase 3 is to reconstruct the 400 and 500 blocks of E. Washington Street to provide a 32-foot back of curb to back of curb urban section with new sidewalk sections as needed.

Legal Considerations, if any: None, beyond normal consideration when contracting for professional services.

Budget Impact: The design will be funded by FY10 Prop S funding.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends approval of the contract with Rhutasel and Associates, Inc in an amount not to exceed \$65,000. This will be the only Prop S design job for FY 2009.
