RESOLUTION 2009 -**

**RESOLUTION IMPLEMENTING A
RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY SUMP DRAIN EXTENSIONS AND STORMWATER
FACILITIES PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City has determined certain residential landowners with the City have a history of sump pump drainage and standing water or erosion problems created by stormwater drainage, and

WHEREAS, the City has determined certain residential landowners despite their best efforts can not resolve these problems without impacting neighbors or directing the flow of water to City infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the City believes it to be in the best interest of its residents to provide a financial aid program in order to assist certain qualified landowners in providing a means to rid their properties of these drainage problems, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to adopt a program whereby qualified landowners may receive certain financial assistance from the City for the remedy of their problems as necessitated in the judgment of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City has determined a need for financial assistance to qualified residential landowners owning real estate served by the City's stormwater infrastructure and riparian areas in order to resolve or prevent drainage problems that may occur on their property.
2. The City hereby adopts the Residential Property Sump Drain Extensions and Stormwater Facilities Program, a copy of the policy which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council and approval as provided by law.
