Subject: Special Event Permit – Chevy's Cinco de Mayo Celebration (MOTION)

List of committees that have reviewed: The Community Development Committee reviewed this application at its April 13, 2009 meeting and unanimously recommended it for approval.

Background:

- Applicant: Larry Simmonds for Chevy's Fresh Mex Restaurant
- Special Event Permit for annual Cinco de Mayo Celebration
- Event will be held on May 5, 2009
- Location: Chevy's Fresh Mex Restaurant at 1305 Central Park Drive
- Hours of Operation: 11:00am to midnight
- There will be music provided by a DJ, dancing, food and drinks, but there will be no live bands this year.
- There will be no tent this year.
- Security will be provided by 4 security personnel.
- Six portable toilets will be provided on site.
- Signage includes banners, pennants, and streamers mounted only on the building.
- Additional parking will be provided on the unpaved lot between Chevy's and Days Inn as in previous years. Applicant has provided written authorization from the property owner to use this lot for parking.
