Subject: **Special Event Permit for VFW Post 805 and Auxiliary "Street Festival" (MOTION)**

List of committees that have reviewed: The Community Development Committee reviewed and was unable to make a recommendation due to lack of quorum. The consensus of those present was supportive of the event.

Background:

- Applicant: VFW Post 805 and Auxiliary
- Special Event Permit to conduct a Street Festival within the 200 block of W. 1st Street.
- Event is planned from 11:00 AM to 9:00 PM on Saturday August 8, with live music.
- Includes closure of a portion of W. 1st Street from Cherry to Oak, between the hours 8:00 AM to 11:00 PM for the purpose of set up and clean up.
- No outdoor beer sales will be conducted. Organization has a valid State liquor license.
- Expected attendance is between 1,000 and 2,000 persons.
- In case of rain or other inclement weather, the event will be cancelled.
- No signage to advertise event is requested.
- Organization has provided proof of liability insurance listing the City as additional insurer.
- Police, Fire and Public Works Departments have approved the event.
