Background: The City recently acquired the parcel to allow the connection of a 16-inch diameter water main on Long Drive with a 16-inch diameter water main on Hartman Lane without disturbing the right-of-way along Famous Avenue and to allow for re-profiling or movement of a major drainage way from St. Ellen Mine Park to Hartman Lane. Additionally, the parcel would be used in any future extension of Ashland Avenue from Fairview Heights into O'Fallon.

Legal Considerations, if any: None, beyond the normal ones associated with seeking and obtaining professional services.

Budget Impact: The fairly low cost of the services sought can be accommodated in current the current budgets for stormwater and water improvements.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends approval of the contract with Sherbut-Carson-Claxton, in an amount not to exceed \$6,540.00.
