**Subject:** ORDINANCE – No Standing, No Stopping – Ferncliffe Court Stub (off of Shadow Ridge Crossing)

**List of committees that have reviewed:** Public Works.

**Background:** With the opening of the new Carriel Junior High School on Seven Hills Road, there has been an marked increase in traffic in the area. Stopping, standing, and parking on Ferncliffe Court Stub (off of Shadow Ridge Crossing) to drop-off and pick-up children has come with the opening. Traffic along Shadow Ridge, a residential area, is tolerable, but the stopping, standing, and parking on the Ferncliffe Court stub is a concern. Drivers become trapped in the stub when they turn into it and others park or stop behind them. The residents at 1110 and 1114 Shadow Ridge Crossing, whose driveways empty onto the stub also become trapped by the vehicles with deliveries and pickups. Additionally, with extra-curricular activities of the school located adjacent to the stub, non-residents will be park in the stub and if not regulated will double park there. Some form of control is needed. Due to the potential for gridlock both the North and South sides of Ferncliffe Court Stub (off of Shadow Ridge Crossing) as well as its eastern terminus need to be designated as a No Stopping, Standing and Parking area; except by permit only (permits to be issued to residents of 1110 and 1114 Shadow Ridge).

**Legal Considerations, if any:** Enforcement issues.

**Budget Impact:** Public Works has funds in its current operating budget for the signage needed as well as permit decals.

**Staff recommendation:** Designate the stub a no standing, no stopping area with exception of the residents at 1110 and 1114 Shadow Ridge Crossing.
