**List of committees that have reviewed:** The Community Development Committee reviewed this application at its August 24, 2009 meeting and unanimously recommended it for approval.

### **Background:**

- Applicant: O'Fallon United Church of Christ
- Special Event Permit for Wurstmarkt Dinner and Beer Garden on Thursday, October 15, 2009.
- Hours of Operation: 4pm to 8pm.
- Location: United Church of Christ located at 206 W. Adams Street.
- Event includes sausage dinner in church basement and a Beer Garden to be set up in the front yard area of the church with seating for individuals to have dinner there.
- Beer will be sold only during the duration of the dinner and will not be sold before or after the event. The church has received the proper liquor permit.
- Proof of Liability Insurance naming City as additional insurer is not required for this event, since no activities will be on City property/ROW.
- There is no special assistance requested from the City.
- Access to church basements is available by elevator, restrooms are handicap accessible, and the Beer Garden is outside on flat ground with no restrictions.
