A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A BINDING REFERENDUM TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY TO DISCONTINUE THE ELECTED OFFICE OF CITY TREASURER

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 6(f) of the Illinois Constitution authorizes home rule municipalities to provide for their officers, their manner of selection and terms of office as approved by referendum; and

WHEREAS, Section 28-1 and Section 28-7 of the Illinois Election Code (10 ILCS 5/10-1, *et seq.*) authorizes Illinois municipalities to submit a public question via binding referendum to their voters under Section VII of the Illinois Constitution at any regularly scheduled election; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of O'Fallon find it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of O'Fallon to discontinue the elected office of City Treasurer at the conclusion of the term of service of the existing elected treasurer and do devolve the duties of City Treasurer on other City offices.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS THAT:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and City Council of the City of O'Fallon find and determine that all of the recitals contained in the whereas paragraphs of this Resolution are full, true and correct and are incorporated by reference into this Resolution.

SECTION 2: The following public question be submitted to the voters of the City of O'Fallon at the general primary election scheduled to be held on Tuesday, the 2nd day of February 2010:

Shall the City of O'Fallon discontinue the elected office of City Treasurer and devolve the duties of the Treasurer on other City offices?	Yes	<input type="checkbox"/>

SECTION 3: The City Clerk shall, not less than sixty-one (61) days before the general primary election to be held on February 2, 2010, certify to the County Clerk of St. Clair County, the proposition as hereinabove set forth to be submitted to the voters of the City at said Election. Such certification shall include the form of the public question to be placed on the ballot, the date on which the public question was initiated by the adoption of this Resolution, and a certified copy of this Resolution.

SECTION 4: Notice of said Election (the "Notice") and the referendum shall be given in accordance with the Election Code of the State of Illinois, 10 ILCS 5/1-1 *et seq.*, (the "Election Code") by the County Clerk.
