Subject: Motion-Award Bid to RCP Shelters for pavilions in the amount not to exceed \$22,410

List of committees that have reviewed: Parks & Environment discussed during the budget & grant application process.

Background: The City of O'Fallon Parks & Recreation Department (OPRD) was awarded a grant for \$25,000 for improvements to Rock Springs Park. Americana Shelters bid was rejected due to the fact that steel beams were substituted for the specified laminated wood beams. RCP Shelters was the low bid. The structural improvements are (1) 24' X 28'-pavilion, (2) 10' x 10'-mini pavilions and (1) Information Kiosk included in this bid. The Noon & Sunrise Rotary Clubs will provide additional funds and labor. Eagle Scout candidates Luke Bennett and Jarvis Trotter will provide additional labor to construct the mini pavilions and kiosk. Additionally, a waterline and fountain will be added to the Dog Park. The cost and specifications were within expectations.

Budget Impact: Approved in the FY10 Parks & Recreation Budget, Parks & Recreation received a \$25,000 grant from St. Clair Grant Commission.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends awarding the bid to RCP Shelters in amount not exceed \$22,410.
