Item 1. Alarm Registration Program and Fees – Capt. An Alderman asked how these businesses were issued the written warning and Capt. Wild informed the Committee that an individual went to each business/resident and hand delivered them a written warning. The Committee requested a spread sheet listing all the business/residents to include single alarm activations received in a 30-day period.

Item 1. Peddler's License Amendment – Capt. Wild provided a handout on an Ordinance to amend the Peddler's License Annual Fees. Chairman Drolet read the proposed ordinance to the Committee and discussions followed. The Ordinance is requesting to raise the Annual Peddler's License fees from \$25.00 to \$50.00 and to eliminate the \$5.00 daily fee. Aldermen inquired if this fee would fall under all peddlers, i.e. girl scouts (cookies), boy scouts, etc. Chairman Drolet informed the Committee that these organizations were solicitors and exempt from these specific fees. The peddler's license would be for those individuals that would come into the City and sell from hotel rooms or other buildings open to the public. A Motion was made by Alderman Cozad to recommend to Council to amend the current ordinance to raise the annual peddler's

license fees from \$25.00 to \$50.00 and to eliminate the \$5.00 daily fee, the Motion was seconded by Alderman Engler. All ayes (copy of ordinance attached)
