Subject: RESOLUTION – Jamestown Road Culvert Lining Proposal

List of committees that have reviewed: None; however, the problem has been briefed to the Public Works Committee.

Background: The culvert pipes running under Jamestown Road on a reach of Rock Spring Creek between Monterey and Holliday Drives have developed faulty joints and are generally deteriorating. Soil over the top of the culverts and under Jamestown Road is washing into the culverts and threatening to undermine the roadway there.

Legal Considerations, if any: None beyond that for obtaining consulting services.

Budget Impact: Funding for this design will come from Proposition S funds set aside for stormwater engineering in the FY11 budget as a priority due to the threat of road collapse.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends execution of the RESOLUTION for an agreement with Hoelscher in an amount of \$39,700 to conduct the field surveying, design the use of polyethylene pipe to line the existing pipes, prepare construction drawings and specifications, bid documents, and provide construction observation and as-built plans.
