Subject: MOTION – ESRI Enterprise Software License Agreement

Background: The attached quotation is for our standard software maintenance and licensing for a year with ESRI provider of our GIS software. Keeping our maintenance current licensing entitles us to exclusive benefits and use of the software. ESRI is a premier provider of GIS software, internationally. It has become a standard that all other infrastructure maintenance software providers design too. We use our GIS software as a companion to our maintenance management software, asset location software, sewer camera software, SCADA, code enforcement permitting software, and drafting software, not to mention its use to create maps and drawings for everyday use.

Legal Considerations, if any: None, beyond continuing of current license to use a software package.

Budget Impact: Funding for software use is contained in FY10 and FY11 Public Works Water, Wastewater and Streets operations budgets.

Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Public Works Operations Manager, Dan Gentry, be allowed to sign as the City's authorized agent for continued use of the software – cost \$35,000.
