Subject: Special Event Permit – La Parrilla Restaurant Cinco de Mayo Fiesta (MOTION)

List of committees that have reviewed: The Community Development Committee reviewed this application at its April 12, 2010 meeting and unanimously recommended it for approval.

Background:

- Applicant: Oscar P. Victoria for La Parrilla Mexican Restaurant
- Location: 1333 Central Park Drive (Sunrise Center)
- Request permission to hold a Cinco de Mayo fiesta. Events will include providing 3 or 4 tables and umbrellas on the sidewalk in front of the restaurant for patrons – includes consumption of alcohol outdoors. Also requesting permission to display a 24 foot balloon in the parking lot (occupying 2 spaces). This balloon was used during their grand opening event and there were no reported issues. A mariachi band will also be present to play occasionally inside and outside the restaurant.
- May 5th and 6th from 11:00am to 10:00pm
- Parking will be provided on site in the paved parking lot.
- Toilet facilities will be provided inside the restaurant.
- The applicant is not requesting any special considerations from the City.
- The property owner, Moonsung Song, has provided written permission for this event.

Legal Considerations, if any: None

Budget Impact: None

Staff Review: The Police Department had no issues with the request. The Fire Department requested that the balloon not block the drive aisles and avoid any light poles. Staff recommends approval of the Special Event with the following conditions:

1. The balloon tethering must be inspected and approved by a City building inspector prior to installation.
2. Outdoor consumption of alcohol is limited to the 3 or 4 tables in front of the restaurant for this special event only.
3. The tables and chairs in front of the restaurant must be located so that a minimum 4 ft accessible walkway be kept clear for pedestrians.
