RESOLUTION 2010 -

**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF SHILOH FOR THE PURPOSE OF
PROVIDING POLICE DISPATCH SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the City of O'Fallon and the Village of Shiloh authorized and empowered by Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and 5 ILCS 220/1 et seq., to enter into intergovernmental agreements, for any purpose, not prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, the City of O'Fallon operates a Public Safety Answering Point and emergency dispatch center with sufficient capacity to provide police dispatch for the Village of Shiloh ; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Shiloh desires to have the City of O'Fallon provide dispatch services from its PSAP; and

WHEREAS, this Intergovernmental Agreement is necessary to alert the Emergency Telephone System Board of the parties desire to route 911 calls to the appropriate location; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:**

That the City of O'Fallon authorizes the Mayor to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Village of Shiloh for the purpose of providing dispatch services.
