RESOLUTION 2010 -

**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH
THE ST. CLAIR SPECIAL EMERGENCY SERVICES ASSOCIATION**

WHEREAS, the St. Clair Special Emergency Services Association is a team made up of emergency first responders who provide response to large scale incidents throughout the Metro area, and;

WHEREAS, from-time-to-time the team finds itself facing dangerous situations without sufficient EMS resources on hand to support the members of the team, and;

WHEREAS, the City Of O'Fallon provides Advanced Life Support Emergency Medical Services and has the capacity provide a staffed ambulance to respond and provide mutual aid to support the SCSESA team without effecting service delivery in the community, and;

WHEREAS, the SCSESA has agreed to provide Professional Liability Insurance for City of O'Fallon employees supporting the team and the Regional EMS authority has approved of the potential extra-territorial use of Region IV medics, and;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:**

That the City of O'Fallon authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with St. Clair Special Emergency Services Association of EMS services in support of the team.
