Subject: Resolution: Coordinated Communications Service Contract (Shiloh)

List of committees that have reviewed: Public Safety (earlier draft)

Background: This contract outlines the agreement between the City of O'Fallon and the Village of Shiloh with regard to providing police dispatch services. The contract calls for the Village of Shiloh to pay \$100,000.00 annually each year for three (3) years for 24/7/365 dispatch services. This item was originally on the agenda for May 17, 2010 but was put on-hold after Shiloh request some changes. The following was added:

Section 6: Year one shall be prorated, in monthly increments of \$8,333.00, to the actual start date of services being provided. Quarterly payments shall be considered payment in advance for the preceding 3 months of services to be provided by the Provider.

Section 7: or mobile assets

Section 9: 120 days prior to the termination of the contract the Provider and Recipient shall strive to reach an agreement for any renewal of this contract.

Section 10: The conditions set forth in this Coordinated Communications Contract shall be in effect for three (3) years from the date of the initial agreement with an expiration date of April 30, 2013. A contract year is based on the Fiscal Year, May thru April.

Legal Considerations, if any: the City Attorney has reviewed and approved.

Budget Impact: Positive revenue.

Staff recommendation: Approval
