Subject: RESOLUTION – Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity Grant For Southview Subdivision Storm Drainage Repairs

List of committees that have reviewed: None

Background: Currently the Southview Subdivision area is experiencing local street and area flooding due to deteriorating conditions of the existing stormwater system. The areas for consideration include numerous specified locations that have previously been identified in a 2008 Southview Gardens Drainage Improvements study completed by Rhutasel and Associates, Inc. The City of O'Fallon has the opportunity to secure a grant in the amount of \$89,000 for stormwater remediation projects from the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity. The application has been submitted. These funds, while not enough to do all needed repairs, will make a significant impact (approximately 42% of the engineer's estimate for improvements) towards restoration of functionality of the stormwater system.

Legal Considerations, if any: None, beyond normal consideration when applying for a government grant.

Budget Impact: None, design is complete.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends approval of the resolution allowing for the application of the \$89,000 grant.
